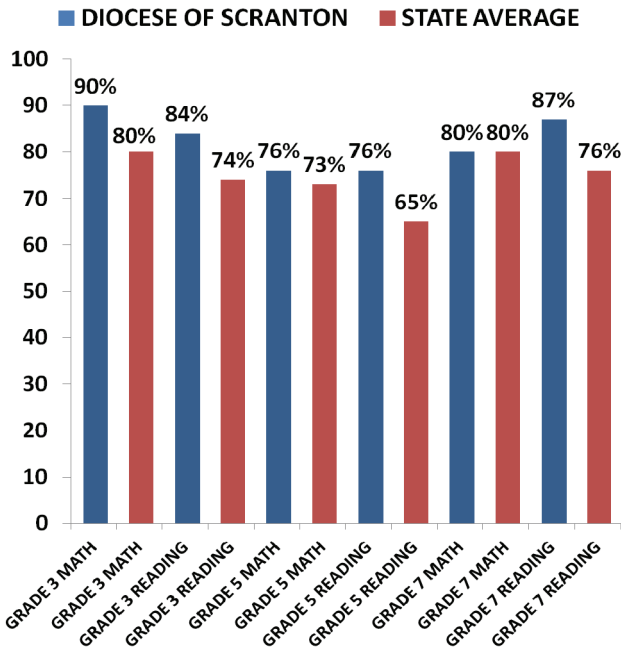
Mission Statement
