The final text of the *Misal Romano, Tercera Edición* was received from the Holy See in August 2017 and the mandatory implementation date has been set for the First Sunday of Advent, December 2, <u>2018</u>. A first-use date has also been set for Pentecost Sunday, May 20, 2018. There will be three publishers of the ritual edition: Catholic Book Publishing Co., Liturgical Press, and Magnificat.
