

The final text of the *Misal Romano, Tercera Edición* was received from the Holy See in August 2017 and the mandatory implementation date has been set for the First Sunday of Advent, December 2, <u>2018</u>. A first-use date has also been set for Pentecost Sunday, May 20, 2018. There will be three publishers of the ritual edition: Catholic Book Publishing Co., Liturgical Press, and Magnificat. Youth Mental Health First Aid Training

The Office for Parish Life is hosting a Youth Mental Health First Aid Training facilitated by the Northeast Region Area Health Education Center on Saturday, February 24, 2018 at the Diocesan Pastoral Center.

Youth Mental Health First Aid is an 8-hour certification course that introduces participants to the unique risk factors and warning signs of mental health problems in adolescents, builds an understanding of the importance of early intervention, and teaches how to help an adolescent in crisis or experiencing a mental health or substance use challenge. Youth Mental Health First Aid is listed in SAMHSA's National Registry of Evidenced Based Programs and Practices and is approved as one of the curriculums that meet the professional development requirement of Act 71. <u>Professionals and educators may be eligible for CEU's</u>.


