Descriptions of the Options

ARISE Together in Christ: study Scripture with 6-10 other parishioners and discuss how it relates to your life. A RENEW program

Echoes of Faith: learn the basics of the Catholic Christian faith and/or skills for catechists (parish religious ed., RCIA, Catholic school teachers). Online and available for study whenever, wherever!

Just Faith Ministries: offers 5 programs that help a parish group of adults or teens concerned about social justice learn what the Gospel and Church teach and how to apply it locally.

Little Rock Scripture Study: take informal courses on themes and books of the Bible. Read and study the Word of God with your parish or small group. Learn how you can live the Word.

Liturgical Ministry Training: for training to be a lector, extraordinary minister of the Eucharist or minister of hospitality, call the Office for Parish Life or check your parish bulletin for dates and times. Additional enrichment is also available for ministers through Liturgical Training Publications.

STM ONLINE: CROSSOADS: non-credit online learning for spiritual enrichment and faith renewal from the University of Boston School of Theology and Ministry

Virtual Learning Community for Faith Formation: take 3-5 week online classes in a wide range of topics through this program of The University of Dayton. Join students from around the world, or set up a parish class.

Diocesan Certificate in Lay Ministry

For the leadership development needs of parishes, this program is 2-3 years in length and provides a foundation for leadership in a range of parish ministries.
