



Winola, Wyoming County, on Sunday, July 7, 2019. Over the last year, the parish community has redecorated the interior of their Church. The

Parishioners and friends of the Diocese of Scranton expressed their overwhelming support for the priesthood by attending the popular event.

Tournament proceeds fund discernment programs for men considering the priestly vocation as well as help cover costs for men in seminary formation. Funds can also be used to alleviate concerns for men responding to God's call who have prior financial obligations.

With a total of 12 men currently in formation, ten seminarians attended the event and helped out with registration.


YOU'RE INVITED TO CAMP...CATECHIST CAMP!



- and others!


