

This logo illustrates how a healthy parish works. While each has a particular focus, it contributes to the overall well-being of our parish.

Word

We are called to be FAITH-FORMED disciples that are mindful of the teaching of Christ and his church in order to evangelize.

- 1. Promote ongoing family-centered faith formation through accommodating catechetical programs for all ages and groups
- 2. Develop and support teachers, catechists, and all others involved in Christian formation
- 3. Ensure age-appropriate opportunities for all of the faithful to participate in ongoing catechesis through a variety of program offerings

- 3. Increase awareness of the Church's need for and to support people in all vocations: clergy, consecrated life, marriage, and single life

- 3. Encourage various forms of prayer as fortifying shared resources



We are called to be FULLY ENGAGED disciples that live out the corporal and spiritual works of mercy exhibiting an outpouring of God's love

- 1. Provide pastoral care to parishioners and their families
- 2. Encourage participation and involvement in service to the parish and the larger community through various ministries
- Increase awareness of and participation in respect for life and social justice issues

Over the next five years, we, as a parish, will be taking steps to implement these goals. Our hope is that you will take an active part in this process. Opportunities to participate will be many and varied. We want to encourage all parishioners to realize how important their gifts are and how much those gifts are needed to carry out the mission of this parish.
