As individuals we are called to observe this day through the penitential practices of prayer, fasting and/or almsgiving. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops has provided resources to help parishes, schools, families, ministries, and individual Catholics participate in this important day of prayer and penance.

As you know from previous messages, Bishop Bambera intends to celebrate Confirmations in the Spring as scheduled. Because of social distancing requirements, the planned combined parish Confirmations will need to be adjusted, with Bishop celebrating the sacrament with as many Confirmandi and guests as a given space will allow safely. Some parishes previously scheduled for these combined celebrations will now celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with your Pastor. The dates already published are still reserved for these celebrations, with a few minor changes or additions for larger parishes needing more than one gathering. EACH Pastor of the parishes listed for 2021 will be contacted to review the plans for your parish or parish grouping.

All other parishes who were not scheduled to have Confirmations with Bishop Bambera in 2021 will proceed, as planned, with celebrations of the Sacrament of Confirmation with your Pastor on the Feast of Pentecost.




Diocesan Certificate in Lay Ministry Accepting Applications for January 2021
