Celebrant:

Again the high priest began to ask him, and said to him, "Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?" And Jesus said to him, "I am. And you shall see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power and coming with the clouds of heaven." but the high priest tore his garments and said, "What further need have we of witnesses? You have heard the blasphemy. What do you think?" And they condemned him as liable to death.

All:

The kings of the earth rise up and the princes conspire together against the Lord and against the Anointed. A11:



Genuflect Stand

Celebrant:

And Pilate said to the Jews, "Behold, your king!" But they cried out, "Away with him! Away with him! Crucify him!" Pilate said to them, "Shall I crucify your king?" The chief priests answered, "We have no king but Caesar." Then he handed him over to them to be crucified. And so they took Jesus and led him away, bearing the cross for himself.

All:

O Lord God Almighty, who bears the weight of the whole world without weariness, who bore the weight of all our sins, though they wearied You, as You are the Preserver of our bodies by Your Providence, so be the Savior of our souls by Your precious blood.

Celebrant:

Lord Jesus Christ, who accept the Cross at the hands of men to make of it the sign of God's saving love for humanity, grant us and all the men and women of our time the grace of faith in this infinite love. By passing on the sign of the Cross, may we be authentic witnesses to the Redemption. To you, O Jesus, Priest and Victim, be praise and glory for ever.

All:

Amen. Stand

STATION *Iesus falls the first time*

A11:

Because by your holy Cross, You have redeemed the world.

Genuflect

Celebrant:

Stand If the world hates you, know that it has hated me before you. If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own. Because you are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hates you. Remember the world that I have spoken to you: No servant is greater than his master. If they have persecuted me, they will persecute you also.

All:

O dear Lord, by this Your first fall raise us all out of sin, who have so miserably fallen under its power.

A11kneel

Celebrant:

O Christ, as you fall under the weight of our faults and rise again for our justification, we pray, help us and all who are weighed down by sin to stand up again and continue the journey. Give us the strength of the Spirit to carry with you the cross of our weakness. To you, O Jesus, crushed under the weight of our faults be our praise and love for ever.

A11:

Amen.



Celebrant: We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You. Stand

A11: Because by your holy Cross, You have redeemed the world. Genuflect

Celebrant:

Stand Mary sees that her words to the Angel "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word" is being fulfilled as the word of the Cross. Because she is a mother, Mary suffers deeply. But she answers now as she had answered then, at the Annunciation: "May it be done to me according to your word". In this way, as a mother would, she embraces the cross together with the divine Condemned One.

All:

Sweet Mother, let us ever think of you when we think of Jesus, and when we pray to Him, be our constant aid through your powerful intercession.

A11 kneel

Celebrant:

O Mary, who walked the way of the Cross with your Son, your mother's heart torn by grief, but mindful always of your fiat and fully confident that He to whom nothing is impossible would be able to fulfill his promises, implore for us the grace of surrender to God's love. Help us, in the face of suffering, never to doubt his love. To Jesus, your Son, honor, and glory for ever and ever.

A11:

Amen.

Stand

Christ above in torment hangs, she beneath beholds the pangs of her dying, glorious Son.



FIFTH STATION Simon helps Jesus to carry his Cross

A11:

Because by your holy Cross, You have redeemed the world.

Genuflect

Celebrant:

When they had mocked Jesus, they took the purple cloak off and put his own clothes on him, and they led him out to be crucified. Then they forced a certain passer-by, Simon of Cyrene, coming from the country, to take up his cross. They brought Jesus to the place called Golgotha, a name meaning 'the place of the skull'.

A11:

Dear Lord, teach us to suffer with You, make it pleasant to us to suffer for Your sake, and sanctify all our sufferings by the merits of Your own.

All kneel

Celebrant:

O Christ, you gave to Simon of Cyrene the dignity of carrying your Cross. Welcome us too under its weight, welcome all men and women, and grant to everyone the gift of readiness to serve. Do not permit that we should turn away from those who are crushed by the cross of illness, loneliness, hunger, or injustice. As we carry each other's burdens, help us to become witnesses to the gospel of the Cross and to you, who live and reign for ever and ever.

A11:

Amen.

Is there one who would not weep, whelmed in miseries so deep, Christ's dear Mother to behold?



STATION

Veronica wipes the face of Jesus



Celebrant:

We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You.

Stand

A11:

Because by your holy Cross, You have redeemed the world.

Genuflect Stand

Celebrant:

Jesus let the pious woman carry off an impression of His Sacred Countenance, which was to last to future ages. He did this to remind us all, that His image must ever be impressed on all our hearts. Whoever we are, in whatever part of the world, in whatever age of the world, Jesus must live in our hearts. We may differ from each other in many things, but in this, we must all agree, if we are His true children.

All:

Lord, let our faces be ever pleasing in Your sight, not defiled with sin but bathed and washed white in Your precious blood.

All kneel

Celebrant:

Lord Jesus Christ, you accepted a woman's selfless gesture of love, and in exchange ordained that future generations should remember her by the name of your face. Grant that our works and the works of all who will come after us will make us like unto you and will leave in the world the reflection of your infinite love. To you, O Jesus, splendor of the Father's glory, be praise and glory for ever.

Amen.



Celebrant:

Genuflect

Celebrant:

Stand Here in the dust of the earth lies the Condemned One. Crushed by the weight of his Cross. His strength drains away from him more and more. But with great effort, he gets up again to continue his march. To us sinners, what does this second fall say? More than the first one, it seems to urge us to get up, to get up again on our way of the cross. We must pass on to future generations the good news that we are lifted up again in Christ.

All:

O dear Lord, teach us to suffer with You. Grant us the favor of rejoicing over our human weaknesses, so that in all we do, Your strength, dwelling in us, may be shown to all others.

A11 kneel

Celebrant:

Lord Jesus Christ, you fall under the weight of human sin and you get up again in order to take it upon yourself and cancel it. Give to us, weak men and women, the strength to carry the cross of daily life and to get up again from our falls, so that we may bring to future generations the Gospel of your saving power. To you, O Jesus, our support when we are weak, be praise and glory for ever.

All:

Amen.

Bruised, derided, cursed, defiled, she beheld her tender Child. all with bloody scourges rent.



EIGHTH STATION



Jesus speaks to the daughters of Jerusalem

Celebrant:

We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You.

Stand

All:

Because by your holy Cross, You have redeemed the world.

Genuflect

Celebrant:

There was following Jesus a great crowd of people, and among them were some women who were bewailing and lamenting him. Jesus turning to them said, "Do not weep for me, but weep for yourselves and for your children."

All:

Lord, look upon us, and give us the grace of Your bitter Cross and Passion, and console us in Your own way and at Your own time. Deepen our faith, we beg You, so that we may see You in our brothers and sister, bruised by our envy, beaten down by injustice, and broken by our greed and our indifference.

All kneel

Celebrant:

O Christ, you came into this world to visit all those who await salvation. Grant that our generation will recognize the time of its visitation and share in the fruits of your redemption. Do not permit that there should be weeping for us because we have rejected our merciful Father's outstretched hand. To you, O Jesus, born of the Virgin Daughter of Zion, be honor and praise for ever and ever.

Stand

All: Amen.

Let me share with you his pain who for all my sin was slain, who for me in torments died.



NINTH STATION Jesus falls the third time



Celebrant: We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You.

Stand

All: Because by your holy Cross, You have redeemed the world.

Genuflect

Celebrant:

I lie prostrate in the dust; give me life according to your word. Stand I declared my ways, and you answered me; teach me your commands. Make me understand the way of your precepts, and I will meditate on your wondrous deeds. My soul weeps for the sorrow; strengthen me with your words

All:

Almighty and eternal God, You permitted your Son to be weakened, all kneel crushed, and profaned so that He might rise from the dead freed from the ravages of sin. Help us to accept our weaknesses and failings as forerunners of our glorious resurrection in union with your Son.

Celebrant:

Lord Jesus Christ, through your humiliation beneath the Cross you revealed to the world the price of its redemption. Grant to the men and women of the world the light of faith, so that, as they recognize in you the Suffering Servant of God and humankind, they may have the courage to follow the same path which, by way of the Cross, leads to life without end. To you, O Jesus, our support when we are weak, be honor and glory for ever.



A11:

Grant us in like manner, O Lord, to care nothing for anything on earth, and to bear the loss of all things, and to endure even shame, reproach, contempt, and mockery. Clothe us with a genuine love of others, so that nothing we suffer may ever fill our hearts with hatred or bitterness.

All kneel

Celebrant:

Lord Jesus, who, with supreme dedication, accepted death on the Cross for our salvation, grant to us and to all the world's people a share in your sacrifice on the Cross, so that what we are and what we do may always be a free and conscious sharing in your work of salvation. To you, O Jesus, Priest and Victim, be honor and glory for ever.

Genuflect

Celebrant:

At the height of his Passion, Jesus knows that more than anything else every man and woman needs love; they need the mercy which at this moment is being poured out on the world. The work of the redemption is complete. The mission for which he came on earth, has reached its goal. As the sun darkened and the curtain of the temple was torn in the middle, Jesus cried out and said: "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit."

—Brief pause for silence—

All:

O my God and Father, You have valued us so much that you paid the highest price for our sinful souls. Help us to love and choose You above all things as the only necessary good.

All kneel

Celebrant.

Lord Jesus, in the moment of your agony you were not indifferent to humanity's fate, and with your last breath, you entrusted to the Father's mercy the men and women of every age, with all their weaknesses and sins. Fill us and the generations yet to come with your Spirit of love, so that our indifference will not render vain in us the fruits of your death. To you, crucified Jesus, the wisdom and the power of God, be honor and glory for ever and ever.

All: Amen.

THIRTEENTH STATION

Jesus is taken down from the Cross



Celebrant:

We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You.

Stand

A11:

Because by your holy Cross, You have redeemed the world.

Genuflect

All kneel

Celebrant:

In the arms of his Mother, they have placed the lifeless body of the Son. The Gospels say nothing of what she felt at that moment. It is as though by their silence the Evangelists wished to respect her sorrow, her feelings, and her memories. Or that they simply felt incapable of expressing them. This intimate bond of love is transformed into a union that transcends the boundary between life and death.

A11:

Hail, holy Queen, mother of mercy, Hail our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To you we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to you we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn, then, most gracious advocate, your eyes of mercy toward us; and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of your womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

Celebrant:

Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.

A11:

That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Celebrant:

Implore for us the grace of faith, hope, and charity, so that we, like you, may stand without flinching beneath the Cross until our last breath. To your Son, Jesus, our Savior, with the Father and the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory for ever and ever.


All:

When He was nearest upon entering upon His kingdom and exercising all power in heaven and earth, He was lying dead in a cave of the rock. He was wrapped in burial-clothes and confined within a sepulchre of stone, where He was soon to have a glorified spiritual body and was about to ascend on high.

All:

Make us trust in You, O Jesus, that You will display in us a similar kneel providence. Make us sure, O Lord, that the greater our distress, the nearer we are to You. The more we are forgotten, the more You keep us in mind. The more we are abandoned, the closer You bring us to Your light.

Celebrant:

Lord Jesus Christ, by the power of the Holy Spirit, you were drawn by the Father from the darkness of death to the light of a new life in glory. Grant that the sign of the empty tomb may speak to us and to future generations and become a wellspring of living faith, generous love, and unshakeable hope. To you, O Jesus, whose presence, hidden and victorious, fills the history of the world, be honor and glory for ever and ever.

All:

Amen.

While my body here decays, may my soul your goodness praise, safe in paradise with you. Amen.
