### B. <u>PARISH LIFE AND MINISTRY DESCRIPTIVE NARRATIVE</u>: (Completed by departing Pastor):

- 1. Parish Pastoral Council (status of formation and pastoral planning efforts)
  - We have an active Pastoral Council. We are working with Ann Marie Cawley and Mary Hallman to bring about a better understanding of a Pastoral Council as opposed to a Parish council.
- 2. Parish Finance Council (Status of development and function)
  - We have an active Parish Finance Council. The council provides support to the pastor in understanding the financial health of the parish and to collaborate on all financial decisions.
- 3. RCIA and Adult Faith Formation
  - RCIA begins in September and follows all the steps leading up to the Easter Vigil. Adult Education is done in our Small Groups which meet weekly either in person or by Zoom. We also send out Daily Reflection on line.
- 4. Parish Religious Education for Children and Youth
  - Religious education classes take place at St. John's worship site on Sunday morning after mass. This year we began to include children from our newly formed Hispanic community. This is for pre-k through 8<sup>th</sup> grade with a monthly family activity Sunday.
- 5. Youth and Young Adult Ministry
  - Youth ministry is presently inactive due to Covid. We hope to start up again soon. They normally meet on a weekly basis with a summer weekend trip to Franciscan University's Youth gathering.
- 6. Parish Service and Social Concerns We are very active in Social Concerns with:
  - Senior citizen dinner provided by the youth of the parish, Inflation Buster Spaghetti Dinner, Christmas Giving Tree, Food Pantry, Outreach to families from Ecuador, Prayer Shawl Ministry to the sick, Sunshine Group sending cards to the sick and homebound ang providing rides to mass.
- 7. Welcome/Hospitality/Fellowship
  - We have greeters at each mass. We have an umbrella ministry provided by the
    youth for rainy days. We have Hospitality Weekend the third Sunday of the month
    where parishioners visit and enjoy some refreshment after mass. We have a
    variety of gatherings including outdoor movie night, picnic, a picnic for our
    Hispanic community and other events throughout the year. We also have
    luncheons provided after funerals.

- 8. Women's and Men's Organization
  - We have an active Men's Group performing lots of maintenance and service for the parish. The Women's Group is also active.
- 9. Other Ministry
  - We have a pro-life group, Prayer Line, Rosary Group and Online Mass.
- 10. Condition of Physical Plant and Immediate Needs
  - We have three worship sites. The churches have new roofs and furnaces. There
    is a new roof on the rectory and it also has a new furnace. The churches were
    painted nine years ago. The roof at St. John's church, put on last year, needs
    some follow up attention.
  - The areas that need attention are the parking lot at St. Martin's church and the roof at the office and sidewalks at St. Martin's church and St. Lawrence church.
