> As a 20-year-old woman who had never left the country before, I was more than nervous, but I was also exhilarated by the whole experience! From painting and repairing a parish school



It is often said that in mission experiences you end up getting more than you give, and I can confirm that is true. What I experienced on mission in Jamaica changed my life. It liberated me! So much so that I came home with an unavoidable desire to do more.

Unsure of where to go or who to talk to, I contacted the Chancery. That is how I first met Deacon Ed Kelly and Miriam Heverline and learned about the Pontifical Mission Societies some 13 years ago and began serving on the Diocesan Mission Board.
