- You are encouraging an encounter with the living God.

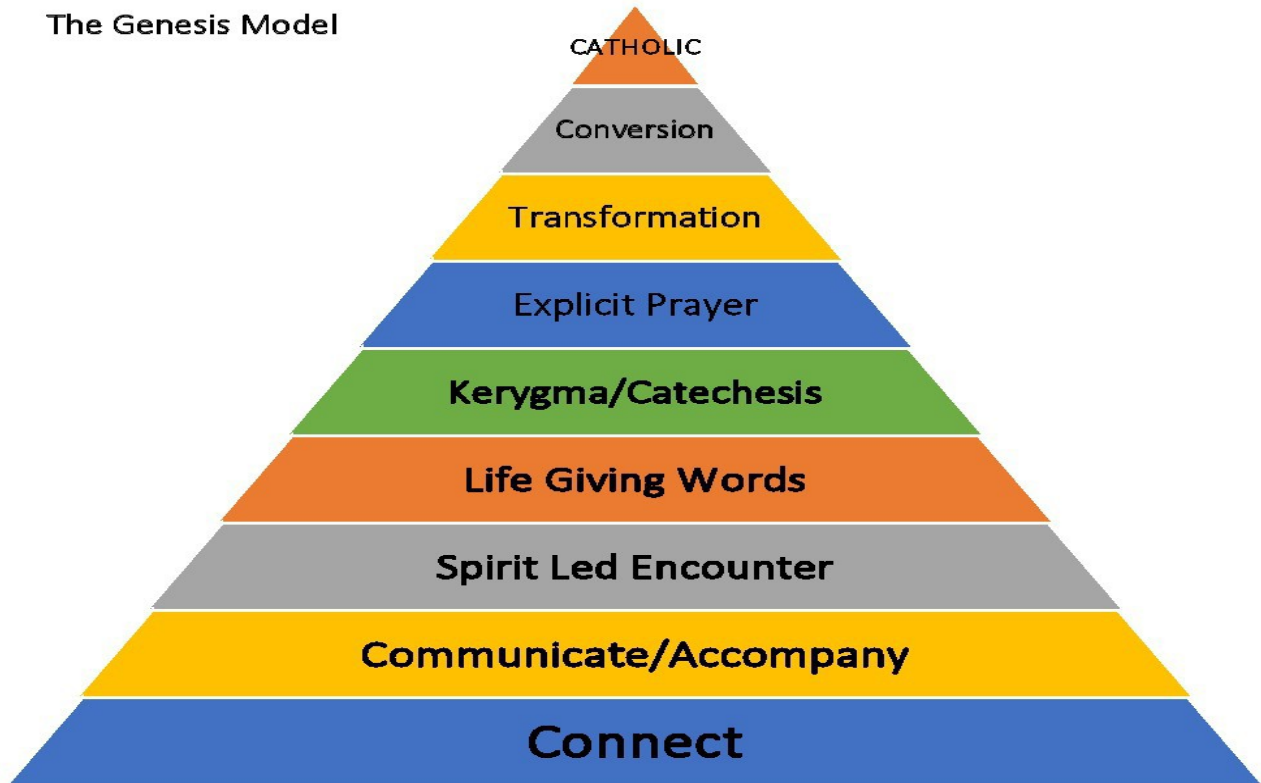
❖ Soul Listening
