

## Day 1 - Sunday, September 20, 2026

### Depart the USA

- Depart Wilkes-Barre/Scranton to Newark Airport flying non-stop to Dublin Ireland via Aer Lingus (Irish Airlines). Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you begin your journey to Ireland!

## Day 2 - Monday, September 21, 2026

### Dublin Arrival – Westport

- Upon arrival at Dublin Airport, complete customs and immigration. Your CIE Tour driver/guide will greet the group and assist with luggage before escorting you to the coach.
- Enjoy breakfast with your group at a local restaurant or pub before traveling through the Irish countryside to Ballina (Sister city of Scranton, PA). Mass will be celebrated at St. Muredach's Cathedral in Ballina. Continue travelling through the Irish Countryside of Westport, one of Ireland's few planned towns, designed by James Wyatt in 1780.
- Upon arrival in Westport, check into your hotel. This evening, enjoy a welcome dinner with your fellow travelers.

## Day 3 - Tuesday, September 22, 2026

### Father Peyton Center

- After breakfast, travel to Attymass for a visit to the Father Peyton Center, which shares the life and mission of Father Patrick Peyton through exhibits and photographs of his global prayer crusades. Celebrate Mass with your group and take time for private prayer in the oratory.
- Return to Westport where the remainder of the day is free for independent sightseeing, shopping, or dinner on your own.

## Day 4 - Wednesday, September 23, 2026


### Knock Shrine – Connemara – Kylemore Abbey – Galway

- Depart Westport for Knock, one of the world's major Marian pilgrimage sites where the Blessed Virgin appeared in 1879. Celebrate Mass at the shrine.
- Continue through the scenic Connemara Region, noted for dramatic boglands, misty mountains, and grazing sheep. Visit Kylemore Abbey, touring the mansion, church, and the Victorian walled garden while learning its history of tragedy, romance, and royal visits.
- Next, travel to Galway for a panoramic city tour, including the Spanish Arch, City Museum, and Galway Cathedral.
- Transfer to your hotel, check in, and enjoy dinner with your group.
- **Dinner & Overnight: Galway Bay Hotel or Galmont Hotel, Galway**


## Day 5 - Thursday, September 24, 2026

### Sheepdog Demonstration – Cliffs of Moher – Killarney

- After breakfast, celebrate Mass at the Galway Cathedral with your fellow travelers. Then visit Caherconnell Sheep Farm to see a sheepdog demonstration and learn about traditional farm life.
- Continue to County Clare to experience the Cliffs of Moher, one of Ireland's most iconic natural landmarks, offering breathtaking views over the Atlantic.
- Take the short ferry ride across the River Shannon Estuary before continuing to Killarney. Check into your hotel and enjoy dinner with your group.
- **Dinner & Overnight: Gleneagle Hotel, Killarney**

**Day 6 - Friday, September 25, 2026**

**St. Mary's Church – Dingle Peninsula – Kate Kearney's Cottage**

- Begin the day on a scenic drive along the famed Dingle Peninsula, once named by National Geographic Traveler as "the most beautiful place on earth." Enjoy dramatic views of mountains, beaches, cliffs, and farmland, with photo stops along the way.
- Arrive in the colorful town of Dingle for free time to explore its shops, pubs, and harborfront.
- Return to Killarney and later travel to Kate Kearney's Cottage, at the entrance to the Gap of Dunloe, for a festive evening of dinner and entertainment.

**Day 8 - Sunday, September 27, 2026**


**Dublin Sightseeing – Farewell Evening**

**Return to the United States**






